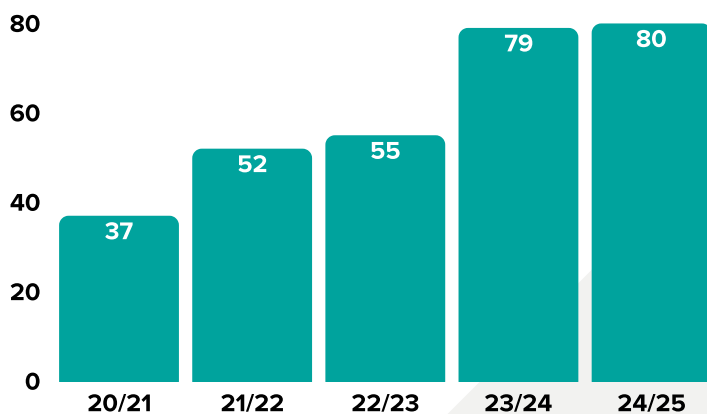
❖ **Fueling innovation by funding Aztec interns for Aztec startups.**
